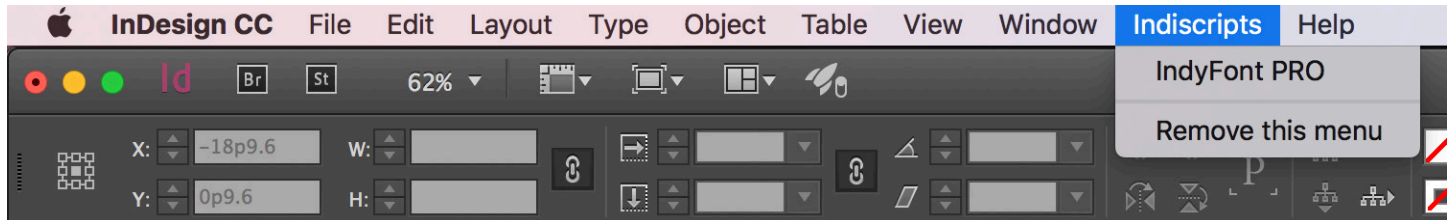

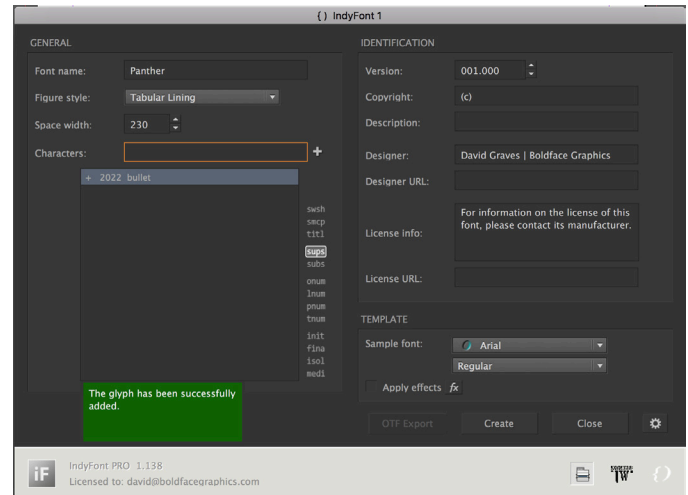
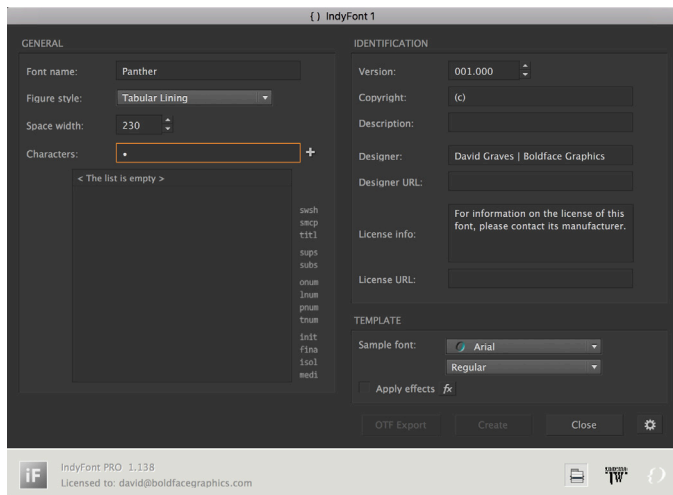

Create a custom bullet

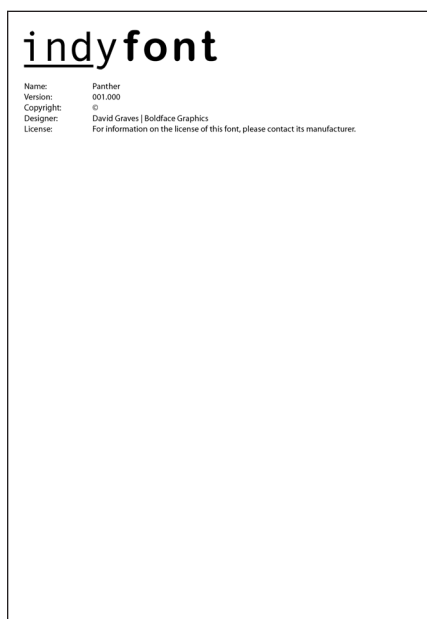
1. Open IndyFont



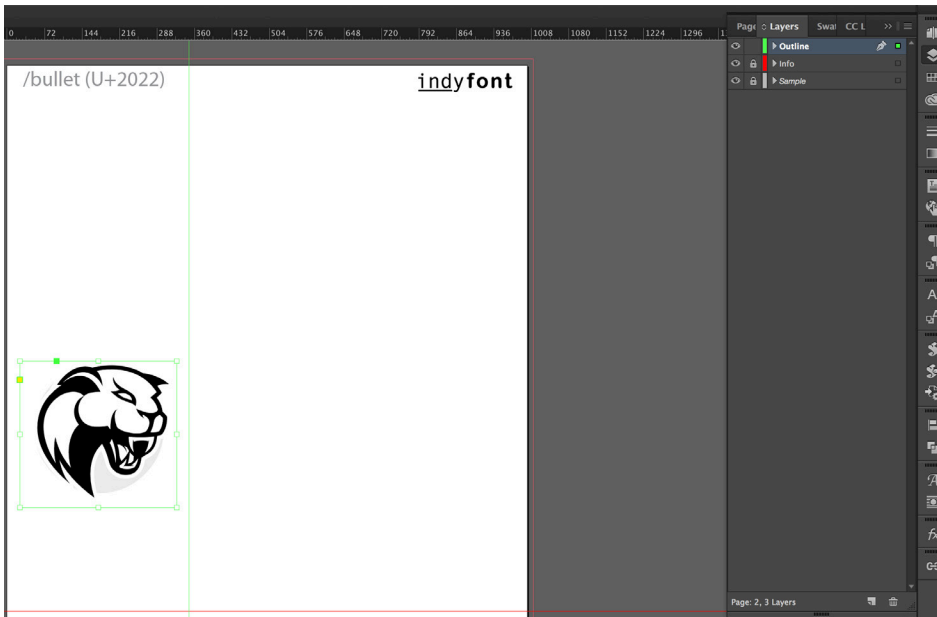
2. Name the font, in this case “Panther.” Enter opt+8 in the Characters field. Press “+”.



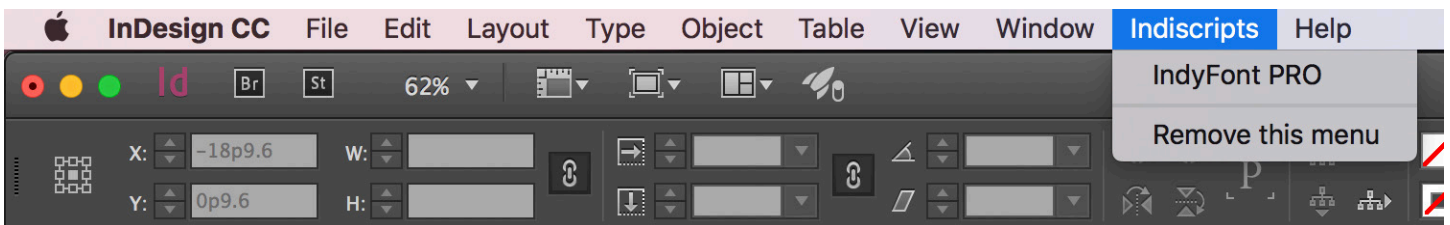
3. Click “Create” and a new InDesign document will open. Go to page 2.



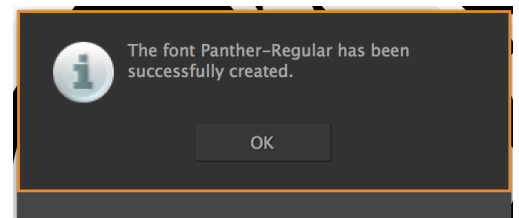
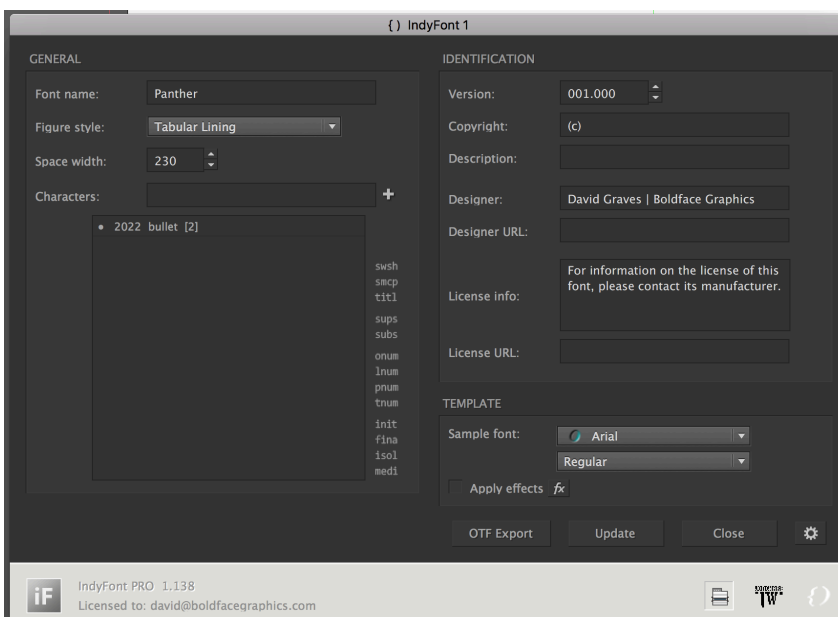
4. On the outline layer, draw or place a vector file that uses fills only (no strokes) and 100% black or 100% white only. Use the shape on the nonprinting Sample layer as a guide.



5. Run IndyFont again.



6. If you didn't make a mistake, the OTF Export button will be available. Click it, select a folder for your new font to go to, and in a few seconds you should have a message that the font was successfully created.



7. Finally, go to the folder with your new font, double click it to open FontBook and click install. It should now be available.
